Speaker for 1st February 2025

Kat Pearson is an ex-engineer, recently turned horticulturist, and is a club member living in Wynnum. She bought her house in 2018, that being a small weatherboard 1960's house on a big block of grass. Kat loves gardening and has steadily turned most of the grass into gardens, creating a little slice of paradise. Accordingly, Kat grows edibles and ornamentals in an often wild, rambling jungle, filled with birds and bugs, including a handful of pet chooks and a dog. Kat has integrated a lot of tropical plants with the edible/perennial plants she grows, and today, she will be talking on "Sub Tropical Cottage Gardening".

Christopher Peatey was a medical research scientist in the Australian Army. His daughter was volunteering with Wildlife Rescue Old, so Chris also decided to join. WRQ is made up of about 250 volunteers from around Brisbane - mainly based in the Moreton Bay Shire area. They rescue native wildlife that is injured or orphaned from possums to snakes and everything in between. There is a very dedicated group who care for orphaned wildlife possums, kangaroos, wallabies, bats and birds. Chris is a volunteer on a 24-hour hotline where people can call in about rescues. As Chris provides education on what to do if you find a sick, injured or orphaned animal, he is here today to speak on "Wildlife Rescue".

Russell Young is well known in the horticultural industry as a presenter, writer, horticulturist and garden designer. Throughout his 30 years as a horticulturist, his focus has been on garden design, which is completely different to landscaping. Russell uses plants that are suited to their environment and to meet his client's needs.
